Dear parent or guardian,

Nothing is more important than ensuring that children at Tulsa Public Schools are learning and growing in safe environments. As part of a proactive effort to ensure that every building remains a safe and healthy place to learn, we have partnered with the City of Tulsa to test all drinking water sources for lead and copper. Testing began with our oldest buildings and followed a protocol from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) that included water samples from all outlets used for drinking water and/or food preparation at each school. If lead is found to be above 20 parts per billion and/or copper above 1300 parts per billion at any water outlet tested, the EPA recommends taking action to reduce the lead or copper content.

Lee was tested in March, and the test results are as follows:

- 24 water samples were taken throughout the school.
- 0 fixtures were found to be above the recommended level.

As these results fall below the actionable level, I am pleased to share that our school has completed lead testing with flying colors!
