Shared Space Agreements

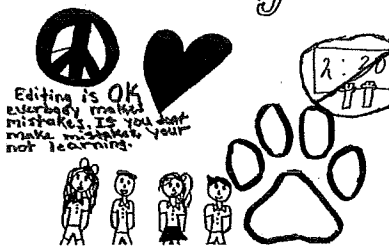

Using a disclaimer at the bottom of their poster, students remind us that it is the process, not the product, that we strive to understand. After completing their first version of our Shared Space Agreements, student revisions transformed the original document into a visual representation of one of our essential core values. “Editing is ok, everybody makes mistakes. If you are not making mistakes, you are not learning.”
